Along with partner Milton Rowley, Mr. Zurn broadened the business in 1910 by investing in a bronze pattern and tooling company and adding Lake Erie Foundry for its resources and castings, and he named the business J. A. Zurn Manufacturing Company. The company was acquired by the Rexnord Corporation in 2007 and renamed Zurn Water Solutions in 2021, and it adopted its current moniker the following year. Today, Zurn Elkay Water Solutions employs one hundred fifty individuals at its three Erie locations and designs, procures, manufactures and markets a broad and sustainable array of water management solutions to improve health, hydration, human safety and the environment. Active in the community, the business recently donated fifty filtered bottle filling stations and filter cartridges to Erie's Public Schools to ensure that students and staff members have access to cleaner, safer drinking water. Throughout its history, Zurn Elkay Water Solutions has served its customers with distinction, and it has truly become an integral part of the Erie community and this Commonwealth.*
